



## **Youth RISE Reflection Workshop Consultancy**

### **Background**

Youth RISE is hiring a consultant to gather the views of our Management and International Working Group, to facilitate an online workshop to discuss their findings and discuss how to maximize the involvement of our International Working Group moving forward, as well as preparing a report outlining these findings and outcomes.

### **Tasks of the consultant**

In cooperation with Executive Director of Youth RISE and consulting the Management and International Working Group Members of Youth RISE, the consultant will complete the following tasks:

- Gather the perspectives of Youth RISE Management and International Working Group members regarding what has been successful for Youth RISE this year, what has been challenging for Youth RISE this year, and what could be done to better support their engagement in the work of Youth RISE.
- Facilitate a 2-3 hour workshop presenting your findings and providing space for discussion about how best to maximize Youth RISE's effectiveness moving forward.
- Collate the findings from correspondence with Youth RISE's Management and International Working Group Members, as well as the outcomes from the workshop into a report.

### **Essential Skills and Experiences**

- Experience facilitating online workshops;
- Experience working with young people who use drugs (YPUD) and other young inadequately served populations (ISP);
- Experience assessing the needs of organizations similar to Youth RISE.

### **Timeframe and budget**

The consultant will need to collate the views of the Youth RISE Management and International Working Group Members before the workshop to take place in early December. A report will be completed no later than Monday December 21st.

The budget available is \$1,500USD, but this is negotiable. The consultant will be paid upon the completion of the final report.
